The applicant has the option of using a Combined Consumers SUD Customer Service Inspector, a Licensed Plumbing Inspector, or Licensed Plumber with a Water Supply Protection Specialist Endorsement to complete the inspection. Should the applicant chooses to have a Combined Consumers SUD Customer Service Inspector complete the inspection, there will be a \$50.00 fee assessed to the customer's account.
